

R. SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE DEAD

SUCCUMBS TO INJURY FROM AIR CRASH
ANNOUNCEMENT BY JAPANESE NEWS AGENCY

DOV, AUG. 23.—The death of Mr. Subhas Chandra Bose, leader of the Indian National Congress, was announced today by the Japanese News Agency.
 Agency added that Mr. Bose died in a Japanese hospital after receiving injuries from an air crash.
 The agency further said: "Mr. Bose, leader of the Provisional Government of Free India, left Singapore on August 18 for the States he visited with the Japanese Government. He was seriously injured when his plane crashed on the island of Igo on Aug. 18. He was given treatment in hospital in which he died at midnight."
 Mr. Subhas Chandra Bose was born in Cuttack, Orissa, India, on January 23, 1897. He was a member of the Indian National Congress and was one of the leaders of the Indian independence movement.

Neemzar to Darshan Nagar. Over 200 kms, August 1963. (Visualization)

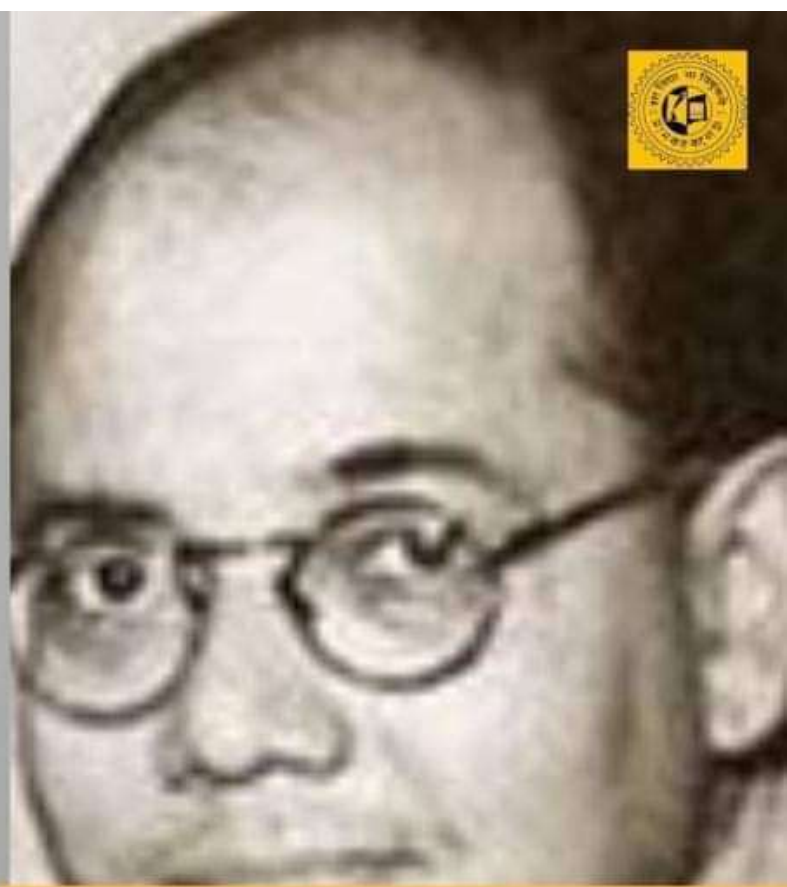
